- At Urban Lab people can delve into policies, urban plans and transformation projects, with a specific focus on both local experience and international good practices.





REACTIVATION OF VACANT BUILDINGS / MAIN FEATURES

Fringe neighbourhoods originated from the massive immigration of workers between the 1950s and the 1970s, depending on the life of the manufacturing plants, are now suffering from **social and economic consequences** of the deep crisis:

- / depopulation of houses and loss of tenants
- / **aging** of the residential population (high percentage of elderly people with low income)
- / crisis of local business activities
- / growing demand of new forms of affordable housing
- / many **stakeholders** at play











TORINO TODAY



TERRITORY /STAKEHOLDERS/NETWORK

- A variegated geography of several stakeholders performing and/or financing activities connected to the reactivation of vacant buildings in Torino
- The absence of an explicit networking of all experiences and initiatives related to this topic
- The need of a subject/place enabling connections, collecting and informing about current activities, future projects and opportunities, within the network and outwards









CONNECTING STAKEHOLDERS



URBAN LAB AS A HUB FOR THE NETWORK

A city agency like Torino Urban Lab can provide **3 points of contact** in order to have a "healthy and effective" network:

- Physical. A place where stakeholders and citizens can find maps, data, information about current urban policies & projects
- Social. A space where people can debate and inquire about ongoing policies, plans and projects, and put suggestions forward. TUL engages local communities and stakeholders, coordinates and steers the existing activities to interlink them and exploit synergies
- Digital. A digital platform describing the territory of Torino and its metropolitan area by relating physical and socioeconomic dimensions.










CONNECTING STAKEHOLDERS



MAPS, DATA AND A DIGITAL PLATFORM

- / Mapping is the key. The interest of all the stakeholders involved in mapping and inventoring shows the need of a better knowledge and understanding of the territory.
- Main outcomes. The confrontation among the stakeholders highlighted the need of a in-depth analysis of the distribution, presence and lack of services to housing in the city, in form of a set of maps and related indicators, following the model of our Geografie Metropolitane platform
- This study is intended to be a preparatory survey for the assessment of focused policies addressing the temporary/co/social housing issue.










DIGITAL PLATFORM











A HOUSING SERVICES MAP

- A public platform gathering datasets, putting them on a map of the city and overlapping thematic layers dealing with social housing solutions and diverse services useful to their inhabitants
- The map provides **geographies of various sets of services to housing**: their distribution on the territory, the presence of clusters, and degree of accessibility
- Its goal is to provide a shared ground for the evaluation and discussion on possible housing policies and projects together with selected stakeholders

DIGITAL PLATFORM



How it works

- / **Gathering and georeferencing datasets** provided by territorial bodies and research institutions
- / Customizing maps: different layers can be overlapped

Features

- / **Local conditions**_ residential assets, real estate market, evictions... maps+diagrams
- / Public housing_assets_maps+diagrams
- / **Social housing_**assets_maps+diagrams
- / Social aid structures_maps
- / Accessibility_infrastructures_maps
- / Public spaces: parks, gardens, playgrounds, pedestrian streets and squares_maps
- / Services to citizens_education+culture, health, commerce_maps








DIGITAL PLATFORM



- / **Development:** Torino Urban Lab is the coordinator of this effort, being in charge of developing the map and data platform, with the strong support of local stakeholders in terms of provision of information.
- / **Final goal:** the platform to become a working tool for city departments, associations and cooperatives looking for spaces, bank foundations, developers...
- / Soon available on a dedicated app and in Torino Urban Lab
