








WHAT IS GRAUSTI MAP?

- / Translation of «grausts» to english is «degraded building»
- / Interactive mapping tool which makes current situation of degraded and vacant buildings visual and raises the awareness about it
- / Works as a public shaming for the building owners
- / Encourage property owners to maintain their property
- / Involves citizens in the urban sorting process
- / The public mapping supports the city in the identification of abandoned or degraded buildings, saving public resources










HOW DOES IT WORK?

- / <u>Submitting degraded buildings</u>: Via the platform citizens can submit information about buildings they think are degraded or ruining the urban environment
- / <u>Site visits:</u> Employees of the Property Department do site visits to confirm the information and monitor the buildings
- / <u>Mapping degraded buildings:</u> When the information is processed the submitted building appears on the map of the website
- / <u>Collecting additional data:</u> Employees of the Property Department provide additional information from public registers and internal databases for each mapped building
- / Putting data online: All data is added to the website
- / <u>Voting:</u> Citizens can vote on buildings ("like" them), on which they want the city to become active for their reactivation (i.e. compulsory renovation)










WHAT ELSE CAN BE FOUND?

- / Precise information about particular address which is listed in the map
- / Whether the building is classified as degraded building and which category (A, B, C)
- / Current decisions made by the council regarding the building and status of them
- / Top 10 list of the most voted buildings by the citizens
- / Information about opportunities to participate in cofinancing program organized by the Riga City Council
- / Information about Commission of Degraded Buildings









SOME OTHER THOUGTS

- / This interactive map indirectly promotes urban development
- / In interactive way involves citizens in the neighborhoods to create a better place for them
- / Possibility to use the information and data available in the map for potential temporary use (with the property tax reduction tool)
- / Potential for investors to find investment objects
- / Could be used as a tool for NGO's to find empty spaces (with the property tax reduction tool)
- / Other
